

From the Desk of Deacon Randy:

Happy Easter Everyone! Christ has risen, Alleluia! This past Lent has been a rough one for us. Not only with our Lenten sacrifices, but also, on our church building. The roof above where the grand piano sits had a leak when the snow began to melt. We noticed it about a little over a month ago. The snow got into the attic through a ridge cap vent and when it got warm enough, melted. We didn't think it would happen again, but then we received the last snow, it leaked in again. Joe and Michael went in the attic and noticed that the snow came in through the ridge cap vent again. There were a few little piles of snow on top of the insulation in the attic. Some of the maintenance crew went in the attic and removed the snow and cleared away the insulation. I called the roofer and he says we could get rid of the ridge cap vent on that little peak since our attic is so big. He and his son will come down and look at it and hopefully get it fixed as soon as possible. Meanwhile, we have an ugly spot on our ceiling for everyone to see. Hopefully, when we come to mass, we will be able to concentrate on the Holy Sacrifice that is happening on the altar, instead of looking up at that ugly stain on the ceiling. We will get it fixed. We will wait for the spot to dry out and have the ceiling repaired maybe towards fall. We have another spot up in the choir loft that needs repair also.

On a different note, the city of Perham's road construction project that will affect 2nd Avenue and 3rd Street has begun. Hopefully, they will leave the block in front of the church to be the last one to be torn up but when it is torn up, parking will become a premium. Both streets, in front of the church and in front of Fr. Matt's garage will be unusable. We are unsure if we will even be able to walk across 2nd Avenue if we park in the old bank's parking lot. We will have parking on the school's playground, entering from 3rd Avenue. We will need ushers (or anyone who will volunteer) out there directing traffic and helping before and after Masses so the cars can be parked in an organized fashion and get out easily. Please jump in and help if you are able. Please be patient as this project unfolds. Thank you for all you do for our parish!

Scripture Reflection by Father Matt

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ Jesus,

Happy Easter! This season of joy centers on Christ's Resurrection—the opening of heaven to us who believe. As we hear in the beautiful Sequence read before our Gospel, *Victimae Paschali Laudes*: "Christ indeed from death is risen, our new life obtaining. Have mercy, victor King, ever reigning!" By His victory over sin and death Jesus has given us new life. He is the victorious King who frees us from slavery to sin in His Mercy. "Christ, who only is sinless, Reconciles sinners to the Father."

Mary Magdalene is the appropriate first witness to Jesus' Resurrection because she represents the sinner who is reconciled to God by Jesus' Passion and Death. Her joyful testimony could come from our lips equally as well: "Yes, Christ my hope is arisen." The Resurrection of Jesus matters to me. It is not merely an historical event; Jesus rose from the dead to open heaven for each one of us. We can personally rejoice in His sacrifice because it washes away our actual, personal sins. I have hope because of what He did for me.

As we celebrate this joyful Easter Season, let us keep in mind that the cause of our joy is Jesus' victory over sin and death. The forgiveness of sins is possible because of the shedding of His Most Precious Blood, and our entry into Heaven is opened by His Resurrection.
